Reporting to the reception desk

After presenting valid proof of identity, you will receive a visitor's badge which you must wear in a visible place.

You can wait in the reception area for your appointment to come and collect you.

Route description

Waddinxveen

Public Transport

From Gouda, take the Sprinter train in the direction of Alphen aan den Rijn. From Waddinxveen train station it takes about 10 minutes to walk to TenneT's office:

- Leave the station via the back exit and turn left into Puttelaan.
- Stay on Puttelaan and keep left when it becomes Eikenlaan.
- Turn left into the street called Vijverlaan.
- Go straight ahead, crossing the road called Sniepweg, onto Limaweg.

Coming from The Hague (A12)

- On the A12 motorway in the direction of Utrecht, take exit Waddinxveen (exit 9), towards Waddinxveen/Zevenhuizen.
- At the traffic lights at the top of the exit ramp, turn left.
- Go straight ahead at the next traffic lights.
- On the roundabout, turn right and then take the left lane (Bredeweg).
- On the next roundabout, turn left towards the N453 road (Beijerincklaan).
- Go straight ahead at the next roundabout.
- Go straight ahead at the traffic lights.
- Go straight ahead at the roundabout (Dreef).
- Turn left. You will now arrive on Limaweg. Turn left again and you will see TenneT's building on your left-hand side.

Coming from Amsterdam (A2)/Utrecht (A12)

- On the A2 motorway, take the exit to the A12 motorway in the direction of Den Haag/Rotterdam. On the A12, follow the signs towards Den Haag/Rotterdam (A12/E25/E30).
- On the A12, take exit Waddinxveen (exit 9).
- At the traffic lights at the top of the exit ramp, turn left.
- Go straight ahead at the next traffic lights.
- On the roundabout, turn right and then take the left lane (Bredeweg).
- On the next roundabout, turn left towards the N453 road (Beijerincklaan).
- Go straight ahead at the next roundabout.
- Go straight ahead at the traffic lights.
- Go straight ahead at the roundabout (Dreef).
- Turn left. You will now arrive on Limaweg. Turn left again and you will see TenneT's building on your left-hand side.

Coming from Rotterdam (A20)

- On the A20 motorway in the direction of Utrecht, take exit Moordrecht (exit 18), towards Gouda-West/Waddinxveen.
- Turn right at Middelweg/N456 and follow the signs towards Moordrecht/Gouda-West.
- Turn left on the roundabout to stay on the N456 (Provincialeweg).
- Take the second exit of the Ringvaart roundabout towards the N207 road (Noord Ringdijk).
- Go straight ahead on the next roundabout.
- Take the second left (into Dreef), after which you will pass underneath the railway line.
- Subsequently, take the first right (Limaweg) and you will find TenneT's building on your left-hand side.
